



Dear Calvary Families,

It has come to our attention that there is some confusion regarding the Student Enrichment Fee (SEF) that has been implemented for this upcoming school year. In order to address some of those questions, we felt it would be best to send a letter to the school community clarifying these fees.

In order to continue to maintain the high level of academic excellence for our students as well as streamline the fee structure, we developed the SEF to incorporate several of the miscellaneous fees we have collected over the years.

At the elementary school, the \$500 SEF replaces former fees such as registration, technology, and curriculum, as well as the cost of continuing our year-round enrichment classes such as Library, Music, Art, Computers, Science Center, and Physical Education.

For the secondary campus, we have arrived at an average of \$750 per student, which includes many of the fees that were charged throughout the year. You will no longer need to pay separate fees for charges such as registration, technology, class fees, camp, and parking permits.

In order to help clarify, we have provided some **examples** of former fees now included in the SEF:
