**School Description**

Calvary Murrieta Christian Schools is a private school partnering with Christian families, offering a challenging education for preschool through twelfth grade that is grounded and shaped by Christian values and perspectives.

Originally founded in 1993, the school is a ministry of Calvary Murrieta. Admission to the school is based on a personal interview and, depending on the grade level, will include entrance test scores, Pastor’s recommendation letter, and previous school records. In addition, enrollment to the elementary and secondary schools requires that the student (if enrolling in junior or senior high) and at least one parent have made a profession of faith in Jesus Christ and maintain regular church attendance. The parent/guardian and student are required to sign a code of conduct prior to attending Calvary.

The school is located in Murrieta, California, a fast-growing community with a population in excess of 110,000. The student body represents the diversity of the city and the surrounding Temecula Valley. The class of 2017 will be the nineteenth graduating class of Calvary Murrieta Christian Schools.
